DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING (GENERAL DEVELOPMENT)  
AMENDMENT ORDER 2012

The Minister responsible for planning, in exercise of the power conferred by section 15 of the Development and Planning Act 1974, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This Order which amends the Development and Planning (General Development) Order 1999 (“the principal Order”) may be cited as the Development and Planning (General Development) Amendment Order 2012.

Amends the First Schedule to the Order

2 The First Schedule to the principal Order, under the heading “CLASS VII Solar Energy Collection Systems”, is amended—

(a) in paragraph 1, by deleting the number “80” and replacing it with “400”;  
and

(b) by revoking paragraphs 2 and 3 and substituting the following—

“(2) No part of a solar energy collection system installed on a building shall project more than ten inches above the surface of the roof plane to which it is mounted, or within six inches of the edge of the roof plane to which it is mounted, or higher than the ridge of the roof plane to which it is mounted, or in the case of a flat roof, no higher than four feet above the surface of that roof.

(3) No part of a solar energy collection system installed on the ground shall exceed four feet in height or shall be sited within any designated setback within a development plan.”.
